Greetings:

There will be a Dual Presidential Primary Election held on March 1, 2016. This is school day and as such creates educational and safety issues with Springfield & Stanley Elementary Schools. The November election is built into the school calendar so the schools are closed and the voters may have use of the facilities. March Primaries fortunately only come around every 4 years, and we need to re-locate two polling places on a temporary basis.

Page United Methodist Church is the back-up polling place for District 1, it more than adequately meets the requirements set forth in Code of VA 24.3-310. In addition to meeting the Code, it has great accessibility.

Code of VA 24.2-310 also covers the Stanley Elementary move to the Fire House. It will be a shared, split precinct. The anticipated turnout for this election is 5-8%, so there should be no parking or line issues.

Department of Elections has been notified of our intent to re-locate for the Primary and we are prepared to notify the voters as soon as you are in agreement with this action. I hope to get the mailings out to the voters by February 15, this will be in compliance with the CVA. As soon as I receive a copy of your vote I will provide it to the

Department of Elections and the Department of Legislative Services pursuant 24.2-307,
Code of VA.
